

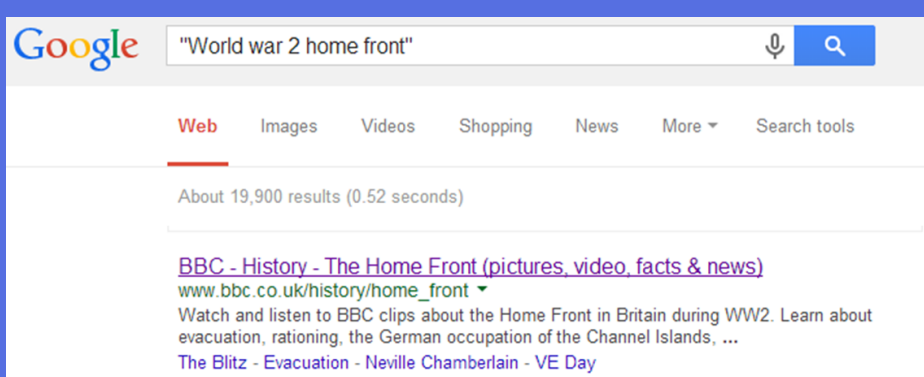


BOOLEAN OPERATORS

Search for an exact phrase

Use quotes to search for an exact word or set of words. Use this for precision searching.

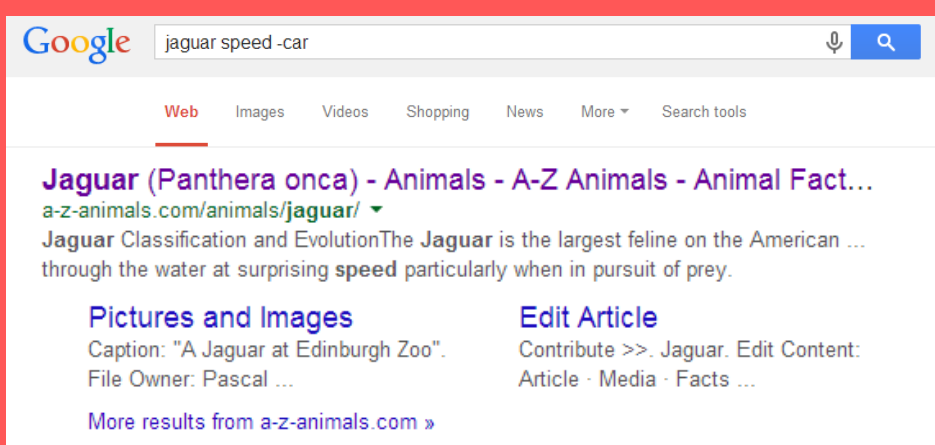
Ex: I want to search about the WW2 home front.



Exclude a word

Exclude a word or a website. Add a dash (-) before a word to exclude it from the search results.

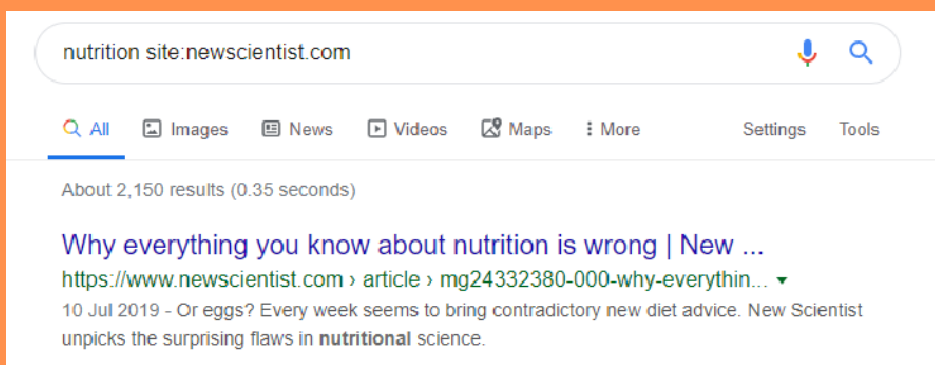
Ex: I want to search for the speed of jaguars (the cat, not the car).



Search within a website

Search for results within a specific website by adding 'site:' to your search.

Ex: I want to search for information on nutrition only on the New Scientist website.

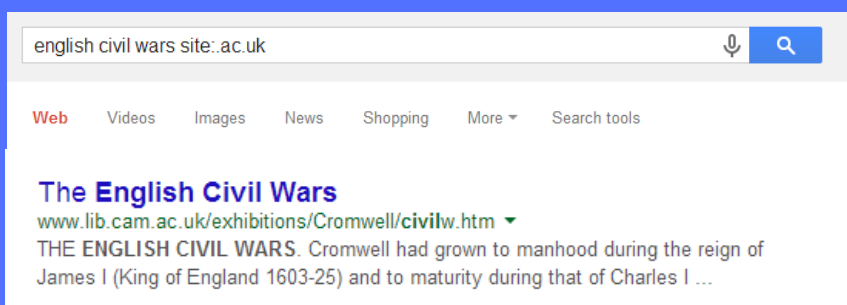


Search within a domain

Search for results within a particular domain ending by adding 'site:' and the domain's suffix. Useful domain suffixes:

- .edu = USA universities
- .gov = USA government
- .ac.uk = UK universities
- .gov.uk = UK government
- .edu.au = Australian universities

Ex: I want to search for English Civil Wars on UK university websites.



Search for related sites

Use the operator 'related:' to find websites similar to the one you've already found.

Ex: If you search related:thetimes.co.uk you may find other news publications of interest.
